It's been a busy time in Doncaster. The Get Doncaster Moving Team has been involved in both the highs of the Tour de Yorkshire and UCI Cycling World Championships, to the lows of responding to the floods in November 2019. We have continued with our iterative process to address the stubborn challenge of inactivity in Doncaster, and it remains a strategic priority across Team Doncaster, to provide the right conditions for Doncaster people to be active in their daily lives.

The LDP Investment plan is submitted to Sport England for Development Award 1.

Systems Network Analysis, "Shape of the System" commences to help the team describe the complex system of Physical Activity in Doncaster.
