What you told us about Campsall Country Park

Number of responses to the survey:

Top 5 reasons for visiting the park are:



- 1 To exercise a pet
- 2 Physical exercise
- 3 For relaxation and contemplation
- 4 To observe wildlife and nature
- 5 To play with children/ a family outing

The top reasons people don't visit (or don't visit more often):



- 1 Lack of activities or facilities
- 2 I don't know what activities are happening in the park
- 3 Environmental hygiene e.g. litter / dog mess
- 4 Feeling unsafe or uncomfortable

Top activities that would encourage people to visit the park more often:



- 1 Nature walks
- 2 History walks
- 3 Organised sporting events
- 4 Being part of volunteer activity



34% of people surveyed said that they would like to know more about Friends of Campsall Country Park

How often do you visit Campsall Country Park?



35% said they visit daily
33% said they visited every week



90% of those surveyed agreed with proposals to improve signage, way marking and interpretation, footpaths and visibility to the park.
