

2023 - A year in the life of Get Doncaster Moving

Realising the impact of our work

Six years on since physical activity was included as a priority within Doncaster's Borough Strategy 'Doncaster Delivering Together' in 2017, there are indications that the work of Get Doncaster Moving is having a systemic impact on residents, communities and the wide network of groups and organisations who are working hard together to reduce inactivity in Doncaster. In 2023, we hosted the visits of the Minister for Sport and Sport England's Executive Director of Place, which has provided the opportunity to share our learning and the progress we are making.

Sport England's Active Lives Survey from April 2023 shows that 33.3% of Doncaster adults are inactive, a reduction since the first survey (2015/16) which reported 35.7% and the CYP ALS shows that the percentage of inactive children and young people has reduced from 31.3% to 25.7%, which is now lower than the England average (30.2%).

Over 100 partners attended our annual summit, which is reflective of the growing number and diversity of people, groups and organisations who are taking action together to support residents in Doncaster. Our 2023 Social Network Analysis shows that since 2018, the number of people in the network has increased from 96 to 563 and the number of collaborations increased from 242 to 1049.

Residents have continued to play an important and active role, through Well Doncaster's appreciative inquiry. Through the Future Parks Programme, we've engaged our 2,500th resident and work is underway in five parks, including a social seating space at Hexthorpe, designed by a student at Doncaster College.
