What you told us about Town Field

In June 2022, residents were invited to complete a survey about Town Field. Get Doncaster Moving and Doncaster Council wanted to know more about what local people wanted Town Field to look like in the future, and what the community would like to do within the space (such as events/activities). - 44% Physical exercise (jogging/walking)
- 34% To exercise a pet
- 31% For relaxation and contemplation
- 29% To take a short cut / commuter route
- 26% To entertain children/ a family outing



- 23% Lack of activities or facilities
- 14% This is not my local park
- 13% Feeling unsafe or uncomfortable
- 11% I don't know what activities are happening in the park
- 8% Environmental hygiene e.g. litter / dog mess



- 58% Community events
- 58% Food and drink events
- 54% Live music
- 35% Organised sporting activities
- 24% Organised walks



- 33% Solar lighting scheme
- 19% Improved entrance signage
- 12% Information on the parks history



37% said they visit daily
27% said they visited every week or every fortnight



73% of residents responded very positively or positively to the naturalised grass land areas that have been left to support the natural environment. (20% responded neither positively or negatively, 7% negatively)

It is a lovely green open space that is an asset to the town. Not many places are so fortunate to have this amenity. A breathing space for us to enjoy.

29% of respondents said they would be interested in joining a parks focused community group
